Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS,** 1,609 Americans are still missing and unaccounted for from the Vietnam War, 7,745 from the Korean War, 126 from the Cold War and 73,054 from WWII, though thousands from WWII are assessed as unrecoverable deep-sea losses; and
- WHEREAS,** the families and friends of unaccounted for Vietnam War Veterans still await recovery of their remains or clarity regarding their fates; and
- WHEREAS,** successive administrations have reinforced commitment to accounting for our nation's POW/MIA's as a high priority of the United States; and
- WHEREAS,** the State of Indiana commends, supports and shares our Nation's commitment to account for Americans still missing and unaccounted for from our nation's past wars and conflicts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim September 15th, 2017 as

POW/MIA RECOGNITION DAY

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
