Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS,** 1,598 Americans are still missing from the Vietnam War, as well as 7,704 unaccounted for from the Korean War and 72,934 from WWII, though thousands from WWII are assessed as unrecoverable deep-sea losses; and
- WHEREAS,** the families and friends of unaccounted for Vietnam War Veterans, as well as countless fellow Veterans and other Americans, still await recovery and identification of their remains; and
- WHEREAS,** successive administrations have reinforced commitment to accounting for our nation's POW/MIA's as a high priority of the United States; and
- WHEREAS,** the state of Indiana commends, supports and shares our nation's commitment to account as fully as possible for Americans still missing and unaccounted for from our nation's past wars and conflicts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim September 21, 2018 as

POW/MIA RECOGNITION DAY

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
