I send my best wishes as the National League of POW/MIA Families assembles for its 49th Annual Meeting. The League fills a vital role in raising awareness and advocating for the return of all American prisoners of war and the accounting for those who did not return from service on our Nation's behalf.

The League's flag is a universal symbol of America's unwavering vow to our service members and their families that men and women sent into harm's way will not be forgotten. A few weeks ago, at Arlington National Cemetery, I spoke of those still unaccounted for. I said then, and reaffirm now, that we will never stop searching for them. Whenever possible, we will bring them home. Last week, I also secured a commitment from North Korean leader Kim Jong Un to recover the remains of our fallen troops in North Korea. To the more than 82,000 Americans around the world still unaccounted for, and their families, let me assure you: we will never forget.

Melania and I express our appreciation to the League for its tireless efforts to support our Nation's solemn commitments to obtain the release of all American prisoners of war, the fullest possible accounting for those missing, and the repatriation of all recoverable remains of those who gave their last full measure of devotion to our Nation. We wish you a successful meeting.
