Whereas, 1,598 Americans are still missing from the Vietnam War, as well as 7,704 unaccounted-for from the Korean War, 126 from the Cold War, and 72,934 from World War II;

Whereas, the families and friends of unaccounted-for Veterans still await the recovery and identification of their remains or, if determined unrecoverable, information surrounding their fates;

Whereas, successive administrations have reinforced solid commitment to accounting for our nation's POW/MIAs as a matter of highest national priority for the United States;

Whereas, information and records from the countries involved in the wars are becoming more accessible; and

Whereas, we seek to honor all Americans still missing and unaccounted-for from the Vietnam War, Korean War, Cold War, and World War II;

Now, therefore, I, Gary R. Herbert, as Governor of the great State of Utah, do hereby proclaim September 21, 2018 as
